### **Secure Detention Per Diem \$110.00 bed co-ed 18 beds**

Accredited by the Department of Corrections with a resulting score of 100% on mandatory standards and 97.4% on all non-mandatory standards

Residents attend on-site school year-round with licensed teachers and gain credit through the Bartholomew County Consolidated School system. GED prep is available as well as TABE (Test of Adult Basic Education) testing and specialized college preparation on a case by case basis. There is a full-time counselor, a nurse, and a doctor who are on call twenty-four hours a day. A mental health screening (MAYSI-2) is administered to all youth placed in secure detention.

### **Emergency Shelter Care Per Diem \$100 per day 10 beds co-ed**

Licensed by DCS and accepts CHINS and delinquents. Program is based upon a modified version of Positive Peer Culture. Program serves Pre and Post Dispositional youth. The residents either attend their own school or school at the Center if they are unable to attend. All youth in shelter for at least 7 days receive a CANS, completed by the counselor.

### **Day Treatment Program (Bartholomew County Resident's only) per diem \$58.80 10 maximum capacity**

Day Treatment is a 6-8 month program where youth are offered Aggression Replacement Training, Moral Reconciliation Therapy, and Thinking for a change. Parents are required to take parenting classes and attend parent support groups. Youth attend their home school and acquire employment.
