News: Hamilton County is on pace for only about ½ of the maysi 2 screens that were completed in 2013. Overall referrals to probation are down about 25% in 2014. Only about 8-9% of referrals have resulted in secure detention. The County is working to collect data on program success. A recidivism study was completed in September 2012 indicating recidivism for July 2011-July 2012 was 7.8%. Anecdotal evidence would suggest the rate has been much higher in the past. The County is hoping to repeat that study in 2014.
