Laurie Elliott discussed HB 1304 (many juvenile justice amendments, including elimination of the valid court order exception for truancy and runaway); Amy Karozos discussed SB 279 (direct file 14 year olds carrying hand gun); Don Travis discussed HB 1196 (dual jurisdiction youth) and HB 1434 (making changes to certain child services and juvenile laws to meet federal changes).

V. Systems Improvement

- A. SAMHSA/MacArthur Policy Academy Initiative. The Board was updated on the progress of the Policy Academy Initiative by Jenny Young and Amy Karozos. Several of the MH Advisory Board members are participating as Core Team or Home Team members and others may be asked to participate on working committees.
- B. Juvenile Justice and Mental Health Collaboration Grant. Kellie Whitcomb explained IDOC/DYS was awarded a 2 year planning and implementation grant by the U.S. DOJ, Office of Justice Programs. This is a follow up grant to a 1 year planning grant DYS received in 2010/11.

VI. New Business

- A. The Advisory Board discussed proposed modifications to project forms to accommodate private facilities. The Advisory Board recommends in the private facilities' local protocols, clarifying limits on information sharing without consent and if there is not a BAA in place. The Advisory Board recommends the private facilities include a law enforcement representative on the local advisory board.

Motion carried (Kellie Whitcomb abstained): The Advisory Board approves moving forward with revisions on the forms and local advisory board composition to accommodate private facilities, subject to the approval of the Advisory Board.
