IV. Committee Reports

- A. Connections to Care The Committee has been discussing where this group fits in with state efforts. The Committee helped organize Indiana's application for a SAMHSA/MacArthur Foundation Policy Academy-Action Network Initiative to improve policies and programs to provide mental health diversion for juveniles. Marion County is the applicant county.
- B. Data Collection Lisa Thompson and Mary DePrez, JTAC, have been working with the MH project on an INCite application for MAYSI 2. Lisa is the project manager.

V. Legislative Update

JauNae Hanger gave an update on the current state legislative session and issues involving youth. HB 1287, School Discipline, addressing equitable and positive school discipline practices to respond to high rates of suspension and expulsion, was discussed and information distributed.

VI. Systems Improvement

A. Commission on Improving the Status of Children. Lilia Judson, Executive Director of Division of State Court Administration, is the chair of the Commission on Children's Data Sharing and Mapping Task Force. Ann Jordan, Indiana Judicial Center Education Attorney, and Angela Reid-Brown, Indiana Judicial Center, CIP Administrator, staff the Commission on Children. Ruth Reichart, State Court Administration staff attorney, is staffing the Data Sharing and Mapping Task Force. They discussed the Commission's mission, meetings, and committees. The Data Sharing and Mapping Task Force is mapping resources and services available in the community, population served, capacity, and funding sources. Information from a variety of sources is being compiled. The data sharing includes identifying mental health providers and substance abuse providers and where gaps in service and resources exist.

JDAI Statewide Expansion. Michelle Tennell, Indiana JDAI State Coordinator, discussed JDAI's background and successes in Indiana, and the expansion to 11 new sites in 2014. With the expansion, approximately 56% of juveniles in Indiana will live in a JDAI county.
